Berthing Facilities

The main power cable replacement project at Jetty D has been completed. We sincerely appreciate your patience during the work period.

From July onwards, Jetties A and B will begin preparations for the WR2 inspection. We will keep members updated on the progress and provide advance notice if any arrangements may affect the power supply.

Wooden fender maintenance will also continue at various locations, and deep cleaning of all jetties is currently underway to maintain a clean and tidy berthing environment.

As typhoon season approaches, members are reminded to observe the following safety requirements:

- Keep the berthing pontoons clear and tidy.
- Return all tools to the dock box after use.
- Do not store plastic gasoline tanks or oxygen cylinders on the berthing pontoons.
