Berthing Facilities

In May, we completed the replacement of the main power supply cables serving Jetty C. We thank members for their patience, support, and understanding throughout the course of these works. Upgrades to the remaining jetties, including Jetty D, will continue in phases. As part of our ongoing commitment to safety, members are kindly reminded to ensure that all shore power cables remain in good condition. We will continue to provide updates on future enhancement projects as they progress.

Improvement works to the berthing facilities, including wooden fender replacement and high-pressure deep cleaning, are currently in progress. Members are also kindly reminded to keep the area beside each dock box tidy and to store accessories inside the dock box after use, helping to maintain a safe and orderly environment for all. As typhoon season approaches, please note that all safety equipment is inspected annually in advance of the season, and members are encouraged to remain attentive to changing weather conditions.

We hope members have been enjoying the new coffee machine and our selection of premium coffee beans. If you have not yet had the opportunity to try them, we warmly invite you to visit at your convenience. We are also pleased to announce that, from 1st July 2026, the restaurant will operate seven days a week.
