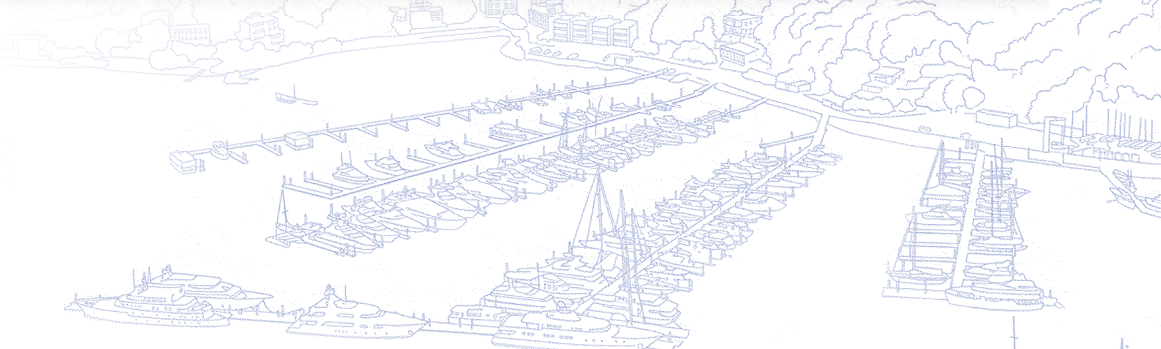

GENERAL MANAGER MESSAGE

Whether paired with pasta, grilled meats, spicy dishes, cheese, or enjoyed on their own, these new wines have been selected to perfectly complement the flavours of our new menu and elevate Members' dining experience at the Club.
